

Ruth C. Rogers \$1,000 Memorial Scholarship

Film Techniques & Technologies

To be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student at ECU. He or she must also have a good academic standing at the time of the award and during the term of the award. The applicant must be pursuing a degree in Broadcasting & Electronic Media – Film Technique & Technology Option in the Department of Communication.

Additional Requirements:

- Must be a junior or senior with more than 59 credit hours
- Must submit proof of personal income for the previous year (or family income if still being claimed as a dependent)
- Must submit an essay of 350-400 words outlining the student's cinema career goals and what the applicant wishes to accomplish through filmmaking

A three-member committee appointed by the department chair will review scholarship applications. Applicants will be ranked using the following weighting: 20% hours earned, 30% financial need, and 50% results of the essay. The award will be \$1,000 for the academic year and will be awarded in the spring semester for the following academic year.
