

The Pat and Paul Gleason Public Relations Scholarship For Excellence in Communication Practice

The Pat and Paul Gleason Public Relations Scholarship (\$100) is awarded annually to a junior public relations student at ECU. GPA, writing ability, and Public Relations-related ECU or community activities are considered.

The award was established by ECU Public Relations professor Dr. Jim Gleason to honor his parents, Pat and Paul Gleason. Criteria for consideration are listed below.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Applicant must be an ECU student majoring in Public Relations (PR), a junior (60-89 hours completed at the end of the spring semester), and in good standing with the university. (If the student is not in good standing, or changes to a major not included under the agreement during the award period, he/she will forfeit any scholarship funds not yet awarded.)
- 2) Complete and submit this application form.
- 3) Attach three writing samples or other examples your work.
- 4) Attach a resume listing education, work experience, relevant coursework, etc.

All completed application packets will be reviewed and one recipient selected and announced later in the spring semester. The \$100 award for the following academic year is a cash award. If a suitable candidate is not selected for a given year, the award will be applied to support the following year's scholarship.
