The Internship is a structured, part-time position, working approximately 20 hours per week. Applicants should be attending an accredited college or university and be willing to commit to 2-3 business days per week to their internship (20 hours) for an 8 to 12-week duration.

Essential Job Functions

The Internship will provide meaningful and challenging projects, specifically designed to enhance content distribution through new technologies that are immediate and easily accessible. The Internship is designed to augment a student's academic studies. Duties can include, but are not limited to:

- Research and gather materials for reporter stories, investigations and newscasts.
- Assist with special projects, including elections, produced news programs and severe weather coverage.
- Answer newsroom telephones.
