The WOUB Summer Media Lab provides student interns with an immersive practical experience while producing daily content in a professional multimedia news operation. Summer interns will be:

- ▶ **Producing, directing, anchoring and reporting for NewsWatch – the weeknight newscast on WOUB-TV.**
- ▶ **Writing and broadcasting stories via WOUB AM/FM and woub.org.**
- ▶ **Supervised by WOUB Public Media’s professional news, technical, and production staff.**
- ▶ **Expected to work 35 - 40 hours per week for course credit with a stipend of \$10 per hour.**

WOUB Public Media is a dual licensee with both NPR and PBS. TV and Radio primary coverage reaches 55 counties in South Central and SE Ohio, Western West Virginia, and Northern Kentucky. WOUB-TV is part of Columbus DMA for DIRECTV and Dish, adding 25 central Ohio counties to our coverage including Franklin County.
